Publishing Scotland's International Fellowship Programme facilitates exchange between international publishers and the Scottish publishing sector

We are now looking for 8 publishers to join us in Scotland in 2026 for a packed programme of meetings, market presentations, networking, publisher and agent visits, and more. The Fellowship takes place in August and coincides with the Edinburgh International Book Festival, the world-famous Edinburgh Festival, and the Edinburgh Fringe. All travel and accommodation costs are paid.

Visiting Fellows will be chosen by our Fellowship Steering Group and emphasis will be placed upon the track record of the publishing company and their previous interest in, and links to, the industry in Scotland. We aim to select two publishers working in children's literature, and six working in literature for adults. We strive to include a wide spread of countries each year and a balance of larger and smaller publishing houses.
